A bold and sculptural 18th century chest of drawers, resting on bun feet.. Crafted with an eye for detail, the top is inlaid with a star, and the three drawers are fitted with a lock whose key hole is on the right side so as not to disturb the clean lines of the front. The form is characteristic of Nuremberg.

A very similar chest from the collection of Bill Blass, catalogued as 19th century, was sold for \$11,400 (Sothebys, New York, 21-23 October 2003, lot 610).
